SUMMER LEARNING

Summer Learning: Registration for Summer Learning courses opens on May 1st, 2017. Preview and upgrade courses run from July 5th to July 21st. Full credit courses run from July 5th to August 4th. Headstart Math programs run from July 24th to August 3rd. All Secondary School courses are from 8:30 am to 1:00 pm, Monday to Friday at West Vancouver Secondary School. Students registered in the Summer Learning programs are expected to attend the full program. Extended absences for any reason are not accommodated. These include, but are not limited to, work, vacations, sporting events, games or practices, family commitments, or music festivals. Please do not register if extended absences are anticipated. Assessments are done on a daily basis, and missing class may result in lost marks.

Priority Registration is available for students currently attending schools in the West Vancouver School District until May 8, after which registration will be available to any eligible student studying in B.C. To complete registration, parents/students must provide the following information:

• Legal Full Name (as appears on their birth certificate)

• Personal Education Number (PEN): a 9-digit number that starts with a 1. If the PEN does not appear on your child's report card, you may also contact their home school for this information. This is NOT the same as your student number.

- Contact phone number of parents/guardians in BC
- Email address of parents/guardians in BC
