#### **MINISTRY OF EDUCATION 2017 STUDENT LEARNING SURVEY**

The Student Learning Survey is for students in grades 4, 7, 10, and 12, their parents, and school staff. We encourage parents of grades 10 and 12 Rockridge students to participate, as the results are important in identifying current school strengths, and in determining areas to focus on for improvement.

All participation in the Student Learning Survey will be done online via the e-survey. It takes approximately 5 to 10 minutes to complete. Access to the e-survey is simple and secure. You will require a computer with internet access.

### The site will be open until May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017 and can be accessed

at: <u>http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat\_survey/access.htm</u>. You will not require a logon number, as has been the case in previous years. To access the survey, parents should select 45 West Vancouver in the district box, choose *Rockridge Secondary* in the school box, select the language of preference, and click *Log On*. The appropriate survey will then appear for your completion. Once you have completed the survey, a message will appear.
