Principal's Award of Merit

This is awarded to a boy and a girl in each grade – grades 8-11. Awards will be presented to students selected by the Scholarship and Awards Committee who have:

- Been exemplary school citizens
- Made a significant contribution to the extra-curricular life at Rockridge
- Maintained an excellent academic record

Caulfield Village Merchants Community Spirit Award

This award is awarded for community spirit both inside and outside of the school. This student is a leader in a community minded club with either local or global focus. This student takes action and has contagious enthusiasm that raises the energy and productivity of the club.

Morgan Backhouse Memorial Award (Grade 9 Only)

This is awarded to a Grade 9 student who exemplifies the following characteristics: Shows a real concern for others and exhibits a genuine kindness and fellowship Well-rounded and an exemplary school citizen.

Rockridge Prestige Award

This is awarded to a boy and a girl in each grade – grades 8-11. Students who are selected by the awards committee excel in academics, citizenship and either sports or fine arts.

- Solid academic achievement.
- Been involved in extra-curricular or volunteer activities in school or community
- Recognized merit in at least one school activity
- Respected by peers and teachers
- Demonstrated leadership qualities
- Of good academic standing and is involved in sports

The student that best meets these criteria is one who sees a situation where help is required and willingly steps forward to address the need.
